NCCI Commitment to Supporting Coal Education

The first part of our Mission Statement states:

Scholarship Criteria

- Pre-engineering, Mining engineering or a technical program related to coal mining
- Full scholarship is awarded to one student per year
- The school determines the scholarship recipient

Scholarship Criteria

- The School must advise the NCCI of the name of the scholarship recipient
- The school is required to update the NCCI of where the student is employed following graduation of where the student continues his/her education after graduation from the "two-year" school
